Bus, Support Vehicle & Band Camp Information

Directions from Oregon 99W (your route to 99W is highly dependent on where your trip starts. Consult the navigation app of your choice):

- Follow OR 99W through Dundee, OR.
- Exit OR 99W onto OR 18 south of Dundee.
- Take OR 18 to the interchange with OR99W. There is a "Linfield College" sign before the exit, which is marked "Corvallis, McMinnville."
- Turn right onto OR 99W, then turn immediately right onto SE Booth Bend Rd.
- The bus/support vehicle entrance is at the intersection of SE Booth Bend and SE Lever Street

Spectators cannot enter at this location. Spectator parking is along SE Davis St, which is one more turn past SE Lever St. Spectator parking may also be available at various locations throughout campus. There is a handicapped parking lot at the corner of SE Davis St. and SE Linfield Ave.

Buses should check in at the arrival tent, where packets will be distributed, and you will be directed to your site. If your bus(es) don't fit in your site, there is excess bus parking immediately next to the unit parking areas (see map). Lots will be open and ready for unit/support arrival beginning at 8am.

Video Recording:

We will not provide video recording.

Warm Ups:

Warm up areas for bands, percussion and guard are marked on the site map. There should be ample space for unit warmup, so there are no scheduled times. Bands should face <u>away</u> from the stadium for warm up, and there will be an off-limits corridor to help prevent sound bleed into the stadium. As this is our first year at this site, we're not certain of all the sound dynamics. If event staff ask you to move, it is because we've discovered you are in a location that is interfering with performances on the field, and we ask for your flexibility and cooperation.

Warm up is not allowed in the unit parking area.

Staging:

Bands, pit and guard will all enter through the south gate of the stadium. Units will also be exiting at this same point, so please follow staff instructions. Please arrive at the gate 10 minutes prior to your performance time.

Props may be stored/assembled/maintained in the area south of the stadium and outside the gate surrounding the field. Ready-to-go props may be staged inside the gate behind the south grandstand.

Student Seating:

In order to assure adequate seating for paid spectators, we are requiring that **all performers sit in the grandstands beyond the end zones, or on the far side of the field, not the main grandstand.** Students will enter through the south gate, and must follow staff instructions to avoid conflict with units. All other spectators will enter through the north gate.

Preliminary and Final Awards:

We will have a "Drum Major and Guard Captain" award ceremony at the end of the preliminary round of competition. Awards for each class will be for each caption, including percussion and guard, and 1st, 2nd and 3rdPlease have your Drum Majors and Guard Captains at the south gate after Sherwood's exhibition performance. Finals awards will work the same way, with 1st, 2nd, 3rd and caption awards done overall.

Staff and Additional Passes:

Show passes will be given in accordance with NWAPA rules. Each group shall receive one pass for every 8 unit members, with a minimum of 10 passes. Your included wristbands will be in your arrival packet.

If you need to purchase additional wristbands for volunteers or other staff, you may purchase up to ten at a discounted cost of \$7.50 each. There will be a voucher, specific to your band, in your arrival packet. You **must** have the voucher to purchase the discount tickets. Cash and credit are accepted. If paying by check, make it payable to "Sherwood Band Boosters."

PLEASE NOTE: **Every** person entering the stadium from the field must have an NWAPA pass, or a wristband. This includes volunteers and staff with the performers.

Tickets:

Adult/Student/Senior: \$15 Children under 5: free

Note: School district/teacher ID is **not** valid for entry or discount

Spectator Parking:

Parking is generally available on SE Davis St, behind the stadium. There is no direct access from Davis to the stadium, so there is a bit of a walk. There is a handicapped lot on the corner of SE Davis St., and SE Linfield Ave. Please allow plenty of time before your band's performance to get parked and make it over to the stadium.

Food/Concessions:

As at any competition, groups may ;provide food service to their own group. Food concessinos will be located just outside the north entrance of the stadium. A menu, which is subject to change, is attached.

First Aid:

We will have a staffed first aid station open throughout the day. The specific location will be included in your arrival packet.

For emergencies, call 911.

Lost and Found:

Lost and found will be at the volunteer check in area, outside the music office in the "Observatory" building.
