

## **Directions to Liberty High School**

**21945 NW Wagon Way**

**Hillsboro, Oregon 97124**

### From US 26 East:

Take Exit 62B – Cornelius Pass Rd. North

Follow exit to the right onto Cornelius Pass Rd.

Turn Left at first light – NW Wagon Way, School on right

- Equipment trucks/floor and prop entrance, unit/spectator parking– 1<sup>st</sup> entrance
- Bus drop off – 2<sup>nd</sup> entrance
- Bus parking/ unit/spectator parking – 3<sup>rd</sup> entrance

### From US 26 West:

Take Exit 62 – Cornelius Pass Rd. South

Turn Left off of exit onto Cornelius Pass Rd.

Turn Left at first light – NW Wagon Way, School on right

- Equipment trucks/floor and prop entrance, unit/spectator parking– 1<sup>st</sup> entrance
- Bus drop off – 2<sup>nd</sup> entrance
- Bus parking/ unit/spectator parking – 3<sup>rd</sup> entrance

**Admission:** Adults \$15, Children (Age 7-17) and Seniors \$12, Children 6 and under Free.

**Bus Parking:** Busses should park in the West lot, which is the third entrance to the school, on the West side of the building.

**Changing Areas:** Performers are asked to change in the restrooms on the West side of the building.

**Concessions:** Liberty Band Boosters will be running a concession stand for your convenience.

**Equipment Taping:** Please ensure that all of your equipment is properly taped or padded. Tape will be available to cover anything you may have missed.

**Equipment Vehicle Parking:** All equipment vehicles and unit staff vehicles will park in the East lot, which is the first entrance to the school. This is the best entrance for floors and props as storage for those items is on that side.

**Event Staff:** This event is hosted and staffed by the Liberty Band Boosters. If you have any questions or require assistance throughout the day look for our volunteers wearing blue shirts with the words "Better Every Day" on the back.

**Floor Storage and Folding:** Units are asked to rough fold their floors after performance and store them in the East hallway that runs alongside the gym. The commons area (guard warm-up areas) will be cleared during the lunch break for use as a folding area. The main gym can also be used between prelims and finals.

**Guard Warm-up:** Units will be placed in a rotation schedule for one of two warm-up areas in the commons. Both areas will be open to both body and equipment warm-up and there will be power available in both. **The warm-up areas in the commons are the ONLY acceptable indoor space for equipment use of any kind.** Failure to follow this direction will be addressed by the show coordinator and circuit personnel as needed. You will be given timing reminders at 5 minutes, 3 minutes and 1 minute before your gate time. Please be respectful of show personnel and other units and adhere to the schedule.

**Performer Entry/Exit:** Groups will enter on the West side of the gym through the right hand set of doors (behind audience). There is a vertical timeline, units will push up the sideline area as directed by the T&P judge. Units will cross the timeline toward the East side of the gym. At the end of their performance, they will exit to the East side rear.

**Personal Storage:** Guards will be provided an area for your belongings, but it will not be secured. We advise that you have a parent volunteer watch over these belongings as we will be unable to monitor all areas all day.

**Prop Storage:** Props will be stored in the East hallway, which runs alongside the gym. Please store props in a neat and orderly fashion.

**Retreats:** Finals will conclude with a FULL Retreat. Units are to meet in commons (guard warm-up/folding area) immediately following the last unit's performance.

**Schedule:** Order of performance is determined by the NWAPA. We will notify you immediately of any schedule changes that may occur.

**Sound Checks:** Show music submitted to NWAPA is kept on file and will be given to us by the previous show host. If there is an updated version of your music or you did not attend the premiere show, please email your music to NWAPA. We strongly advise each unit to carry an electronic copy of their music on a USB memory device as a back-up. We will allow as many sound checks as possible before the competition begins.

**Spectator Parking:** Spectator parking is in either the East or West lots, which are the first and third entrances to the school.

**Staff Passes:** Staff Passes are distributed and regulated by the NWAPA. We will be supplying wristbands for performers. At Check-In, each unit has the option of purchasing up to 5 additional wristbands for staff and parents at the discounted rate of \$5 each. Any staff or chaperone without a pass will be asked to purchase a ticket to gain entrance to the gymnasium. This rule will be strictly enforced.

**Tobacco & Alcohol:** Per Hillsboro School District Policy, the presence or use of tobacco and alcohol are strictly prohibited on the campus of Liberty High School, including in vehicles, restrooms and parking lots. Additionally, any person under the influence of any amount of alcohol greater than 0.0% is forbidden to appear on school property.

**Unit Check-In:** Units will check in at the West entrance.
