- Busses can enter from either first or second entrance



Performance Schedule:

Groups will be adjudicated according to their specified classification. All groups will compete in Prelims and Finals. Please refer to the schedule on nwapa.net for the most up-to-date performance times.

Warm-Up:

The official warm-up area will be designated as a combined body/equipment warm-up time. Each group will receive a specific warm-up area (A or B). Please refer to the performance schedule for further details.

Parking:

Performing groups, buses, and trailers will park across the main parking lot next to Coweeman Middle School.

Performer Check-In / Additional Volunteer Wristbands:

Upon arrival, staff and performers will report to Performer Check-In at the south entrance of the school. Performers will receive a wristband. However, performers will not be issued a wristband until a staff representative has acquired the Show Packet at check-in. Each group will receive 7 additional wristbands for staff and volunteers. A voucher will be included in the show packet to purchase up to 10 additional wristbands at the Spectator Ticket Booth for a



discounted rate of \$7 per wristband. Checks, cash, or credit cards are accepted. Checks are payable to NYMA.

Prop and Floor Storage:

Prop and floor storage is along the south side of the gym near the performance entrance. Please be courteous and put props on the marked side of the hallway so that there is a pathway for other teams to move props and floors.

Floor Folding / Gym Flow:

The show entrance calls for a horizontal timeline. You will enter the gym from Side 1 front corner. From there, you will be directed to take your floor and equipment along the front sideline and pull your floor across till you reach half court. The timing and penalty adjudicator will tell you when to move across the timeline. At that point, you may continue to unfold your floor to the back sideline. After you perform, pull your floor to the back sideline and out the gym side doors on side 1. You will be directed to the Floor Folding Area which is located across the hall in the cafeteria. After you have folded your floor, you may return your floor and props to their original area.

Awards:

Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place team in Finals for each classification.

Photography:

"Open Your Eyes" Photography will be onsite to offer group photos.

Locker Rooms:

Locker rooms will be available for groups who need to change into uniform as well as bathrooms down in performers "camp" area. Please use the locker rooms and NOT the spectator restrooms.

Outside Practice Space:

Groups are welcome to practice outside before your performance. Please stay off the parking lot areas.

Indoor Group Space:

Each group will be designated an area inside the school to house your equipment and supplies. Groups are welcome to warm up in these areas.

Show Music:

Please upload your show music to contest dynamics. (This service is provided through NWAPA) As a back-up, please have a copy of your music on an electronic device in the event your music is not working properly.



Video Recording:

Personal videotaping is permitted, however, please be courteous to the spectators seated around you. Spectators are not allowed on the gym floor at any time during performance.

Judge Critique:

The critique area will be in the library. Signs will be clearly posted to help you navigate to critique.

Merch Sales:

T-shirts and hoodies will be available in the main commons area. T-shirts are \$25 and hoodies are \$45. This includes the front and back logo. For an additional \$5 you can add additional info onto sleeve

Food:

Food will be provided by various food trucks located right outside the venue through the back doors of the commons area.

There will be various vendors with items for sale at this event. A list of vendors is below and more details can be found on our Facebook event page.


