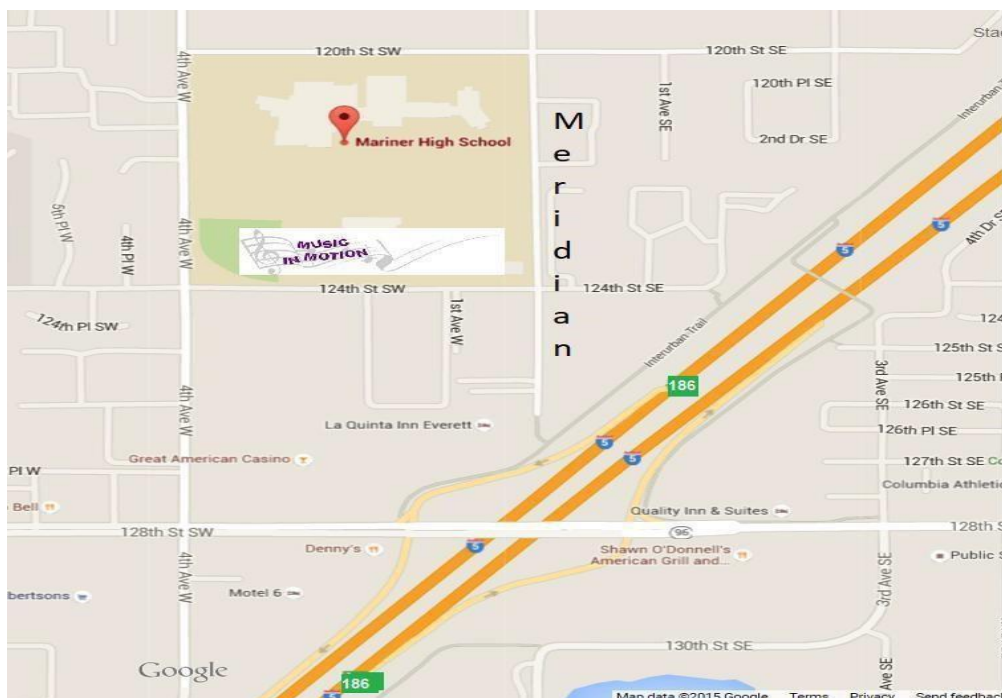
Directions:

From Seattle, I-5 North

- Take exit 186 (128th St SW)
- Take left onto 128th St SW and go over freeway
- Turn right at 4th Ave W
- Turn right into Mariner High School parking lot

From Marysville, I-5 South

- Take exit 186 (128th St SW)
- Take right onto 128th St SW
- Turn right at 4th Ave W
- Turn right into Mariner High School parking lot



BAND ARRIVAL

Bus Drop-off/Parking:

Turn right into the parking lot off of 4th Avenue at the first gate (South), proceed across the parking lot and turn North. Parking attendants and signs will direct buses to unload areas and parking. Check-in with Band Hosts at the southeast corner of the Band Parking area for directions on where to setup camp.

NOTE: Due to parking lot size restrictions, the base camp area is reserved for equipment only. Support vehicles will need to drop equipment off and park in separate designated areas, as directed by parking attendants. The earliest check-in time is 7:00AM. Please work with the Band Host if you believe you'll need to be checked in earlier.

Band Check-In:

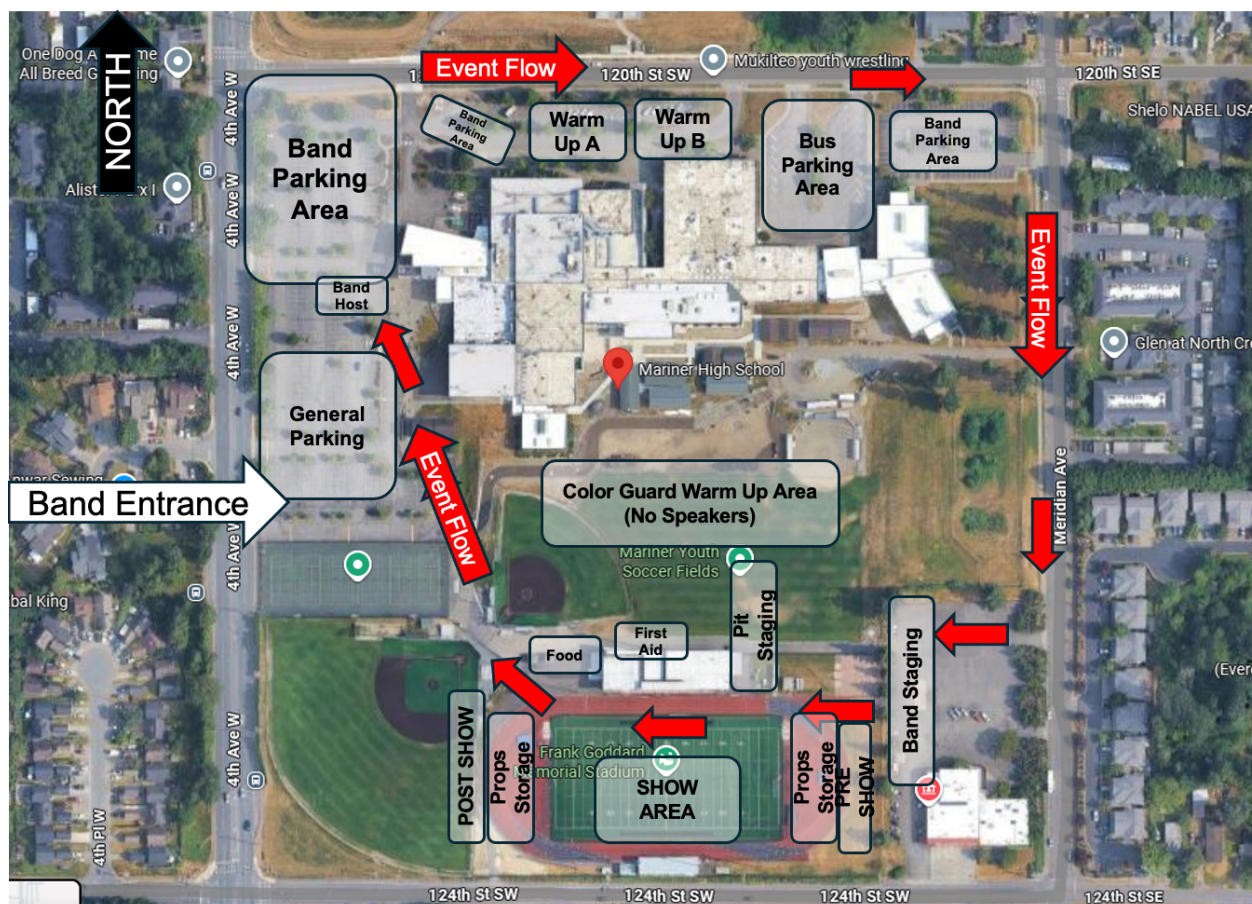
A Band Host will greet you and provide a Director's Packet when the buses arrive at the student drop-off area. Band packets will be provided, including wristbands for students and support staff allowing entrance into the event.

Equipment Parking:

Equipment trucks will use parking lots in the Band Parking Area (NW corner). Support vehicles will use the overflow parking at the corner of 120th and Meridian. A parking attendant will direct you to your band's camp location.

Spectator Parking:

Spectators should turn right off 4th Avenue into the first gate (South). Parking attendants and signs will be present to direct spectators to their parking areas.



BAND EVENT FLOW

Schedule:

Our Event Staff will be following the NWAPA performance schedule shown below, and event timing is of the most importance. Band Hosts are here to help shepherd your teams along the Event Flow to ensure everything happens on time.

Prop Storage:

Prop storage will be available at the East end of the field. All props should be brought to the storage area prior to 8:00am, if possible, and remain until removed from the field after each band's final performance. Instructions will be repeated on the morning of the event by your Band Host to ensure clarity and understanding.

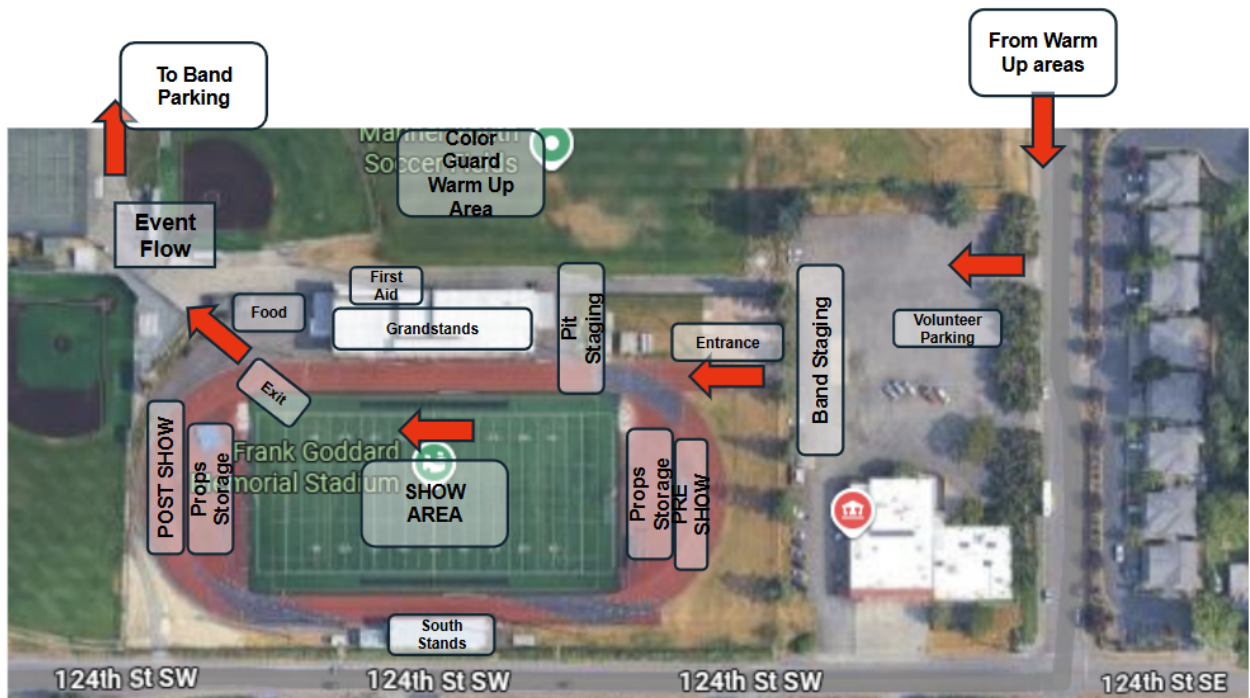
Warm-up Areas:

There are two warm-up areas (please refer to map below for location) in the North parking lot of the school. These are reserved for full ensemble warm-ups, as per scheduled warm-up times. No individual section rehearsals will be permitted in the designated warm-up areas (i.e., pit and battery will not be allowed to utilize these areas unless with full ensemble at schedule times).

Event Flow:

The Bands will make two loops of the Event Flow detailed in the map above and below for the Preliminary and Open Performance Rounds. Props will stay in the competition area throughout the day. Pit instruments have a separate staging area adjacent to the stadium. Please have your Pit Leads follow volunteer direction when staging in the parking lot east of

the stadium.



COMPETITION TIMING

Interval time will start as soon as the first marching performer crosses the 50-yard line from Side 1 (East) into Side 2 (West). Interval time will stop after the performance when all performers are observed to be making steady progress towards Side 2 (West) exit.

After Finals Performance:

Exit the Show Area with props heading to the Band Parking to minimize any delays in packing equipment.

Awards Retreat Prelims/Finals:

There will be Drum Major and Guard Captains only Retreat immediately following both Prelims and Finals. Please have your Drum Majors and Guard Captains at the Pit staging area immediately after the last performance. A representative will be there to greet them and place them in line. All other band/guard members as asked to sit in the South Stands ("Visitor Side"). The top 3 scores will be announced in each class, plus Caption Awards of High Music, High Visual, High General Effect, High Percussion, and High Color Guard. At Finals, there will be a Fan Favorite Award that will be voted on by the audience. If there is one band competing in a class, all the awards will be announced together as one presentation.

SHOW LOGISTICS

Student Passes:

Band Packets received at Check-In will include wristbands to distribute to your students. Students must have wristbands to enter the Show Area gates. **PLEASE NOTE: Performers who wish to watch other performances are asked to watch from the South Stands ("Visitors Side") during the event.**

Staff Passes:

All bands will be supplied with wristbands for staff and chaperones (1 chaperone per 8 students, minimum of 10 wristbands per NWAPA rules). If you have volunteers helping your band in addition to these numbers, they will not be allowed in the gate without a wristband. Each band will be allowed to purchase 10 extra wristbands for a reduced price of \$10 each. Anything after that will be charged at the regular price.
